December 12, 2024

Treasurer Weikle reported receiving \$15,000 from the County with more coming next week.

Gruendemann reported that he has not heard anything from Hawk Creek about reimbursement for a road project done recently.

New Business:

There was discussion on road and bridge topics. Our last bridge to be replaced should be done next summer. Supervisors discussed possible ways of cutting costs on road maintenance for the coming year. We have been spending more than our budget allotment for a couple years, so need to cut back and/or raise our budget.

A notice from the County regarding cannabis production and marketing was reviewed. If this begins in the township, we may look to the county to oversee it.

The retirement plaque is in and may be presented at our annual meeting in March.

Monthly bills were presented for review. It was moved by Sather and 2nd by Buysse to pay the bills presented. The motion passed unanimously.

Treasurer Weikle reported a new checkbook balance of \$7385.40 after using checks numbered 3116-3129, with 3119 voided.

The next meeting including the annual audit will be January 21 at 3:00 pm.

There being no further business, it was moved by Sather and 2nd to adjourn. Motion passed.
